INFORMATION ON THE LEVEL OF THE QUALIFICATION

Level of qualification

Level 3 (Master) in the Spanish Framework of Higher Education (MECES) is equivalent to level 7 of European Qualification Framework (EQF).

Official length of programme

The official length of programme is 60 ECTS and 1 year full time.

Access requirements

Bachelor's Degree in Education or Psychology. Diploma in Social Education and Teaching and other non-related degree with training supplements.

Mode of study

Distance learning full time.

Programme requirements

The programme of studies is composed of 24 compulsory ECTS, 12 elective ECTS, 12 external practices and 12 Final Master Project ECTS.

Grading scheme

In the Spanish university system, modules/courses are graded on a scale of 0 to 10 points with the following qualitative equivalence:

0-4.9: "suspenso=fail"; 5-6.9: "aprobado=pass"; 7-8.9: "notable=very good"; 9-10: "sobresaliente=excellent". A special mention, "Matrícula de Honor=first class honours" may be granted to up to 5% of the students in a group provided they have got a "sobresaliente". To pass a module/course it is necessary to get at least 5 points.

In cases of recognition of ECTS, professional experience, cultural or sports activities, or student representation no grading will be recorded but, where appropriate, the word "Apto=apt".

INFORMATION ON THE FUNCTION OF THE QUALIFICATION

Access to further study

This qualification gives access to Doctoral studies, provided that the student had completed a minimum of 300 ECTS in the overall teachings of Bachelor and Master.

Stated objectives associated with the qualification and professional status (if applicable)

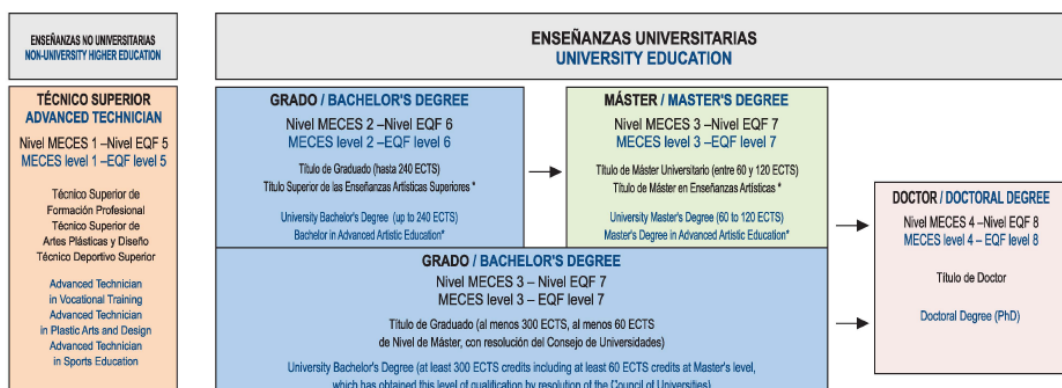
The main aim of this degree is to integrate and apply the acquired knowledges on career guidance, its principles, approaches and models to new situations or problems that require guidance intervention. The objective is to develop learning skills, resources and methodological strategies, through the use of virtual platforms and tools, as well as to apply research and evaluation methodologies to the career guidance field in order to understand and transform its actual situation.

The main learning outcomes and competencies acquired are to know and identify the conceptual and theoretical bases that support the guidance intervention, on adults and youngsters in the professional and labour context, evaluate their needs, labour market risk factors, and labour context; to counseling for the development of the professional Project, designing of professional guidance programmes and information management; to design research processes in this field, and create and spread knowledge.
