### INFORMATION ON THE LEVEL OF THE QUALIFICATION

#### Level of qualification

Level 3 (Master) in the Spanish Framework of Higher Education (MECES) is equivalent to level 7 of European Qualification Framework (EQF).

#### Official length of programme

The official length of programme is 60 ECTS and 1 year full time.

#### Access requirements

Bachelor's Degree, Engineering

### INFORMATION ON THE CONTENTS

---

#### Mode of study

e-learning full time.

### Programme requirements

The programme of studies is composed of 46 compulsory ECTS, and 14 Master's Dissertation credits.

### Subjects

- General Introduction and Methodology
- International and Comparative Policing
- Operational Aspects of European Police Cooperation
- Management and Leadership Aspects of European Police Cooperation
- Governance and Strategic Aspects of International Police Cooperation
- Legal and Regulatory Aspects of European Police Cooperation
- Master Thesis

### Grading scheme

In the Spanish university system, modules/courses are graded on a scale of 0 to 10 points with the following qualitative equivalence:

0-4.9: "suspense"; 5-6.9: "aprobado"; 7-8.9: "notable"; 9-10: "sobresaliente". A special mention, "Matrícula de Honor" may be granted to up to 5% of the students in a group provided they have got a "sobresaliente". To pass a module/course it is necessary to get at least 5 points.

In cases of recognition of ECTS, professional experience, cultural or sports activities, or student representation no grading will be recorded but, where appropriate, the word "Apto".

## **INFORMATION ON THE FUNCTION OF THE QUALIFICATION**

---

### Access to further study

This qualification gives access to Doctoral studies, provided that the student has completed a minimum of 300 ECTS in the overall teachings of Bachelor and Master.

### Stated objectives associated with the qualification and professional status (if applicable)

"On completion of this course, participants will have a knowledge or understanding of a broad range of strategic instruments, legislation and procedures regarding police cooperation, both in European and International framework; they will be able to critically evaluate the police cooperation potential development in European Union context; they will be able to manage cooperation activities within international

operational police teams in order to resolve possible internal conflicts and assimilate the benefits of this learning.

It is important to underline that, on completion of this Master Degree, it will be possible to identify the specific legal problems regarding International and EU law in the field of Security and human being protection, that implies to integrate and promote fundamental rights, professional and ethical standards across policing.

Last but not least, the completion of the course offers the possibility of bridging the gap between pure academic research and police work, facilitating analysis of the usefulness of the strategies of policing in the context of society and its possible transmission to the EU police agencies operational action."

"Acquire knowledge that allow the student to work in the field of International police cooperation in connection with the implementation of internal security of the European Union

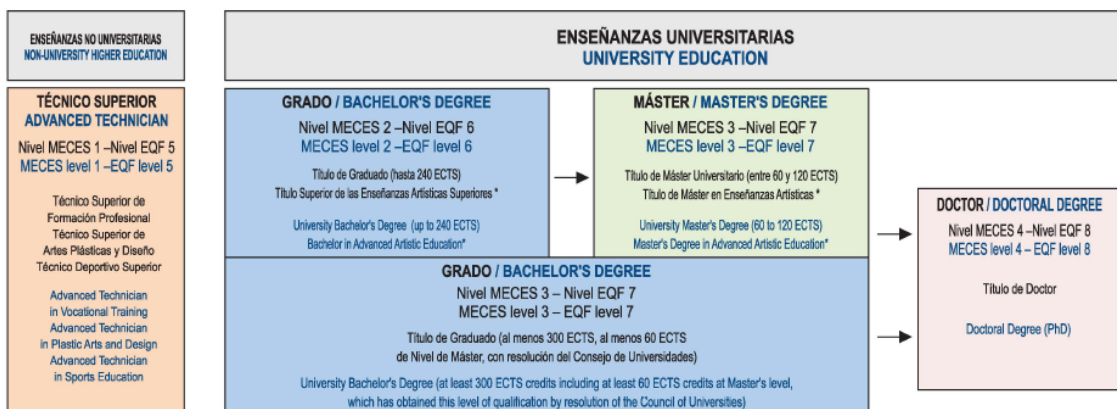
Be able to reflect critically on the impact of developments in International security on Police cooperation.
