Grading scheme

In the Spanish university system, modules/courses are graded on a scale of 0 to 10 points with the following qualitative equivalence:

0-4.9: "suspenso"; 5-6.9: "aprobado"; 7-8.9: "notable"; 9-10: "sobresaliente". A special mention, "Matrícula de Honor" may be granted to up to 5% of the students in a group provided they have got a "sobresaliente". To pass a module/course it is necessary to get at least 5 points.

In cases of recognition of ECTS, professional experience, cultural or sports activities, or student representation no grading will be recorded but, where appropriate, the word "Apto".

INFORMATION ON THE FUNCTION OF THE QUALIFICATION

Access to further study

This qualification gives access to Doctoral studies, provided that the student has completed a minimum of 300 ECTS in the overall teachings of Bachelor and Master.

Stated objectives associated with the qualification and professional status (if applicable)

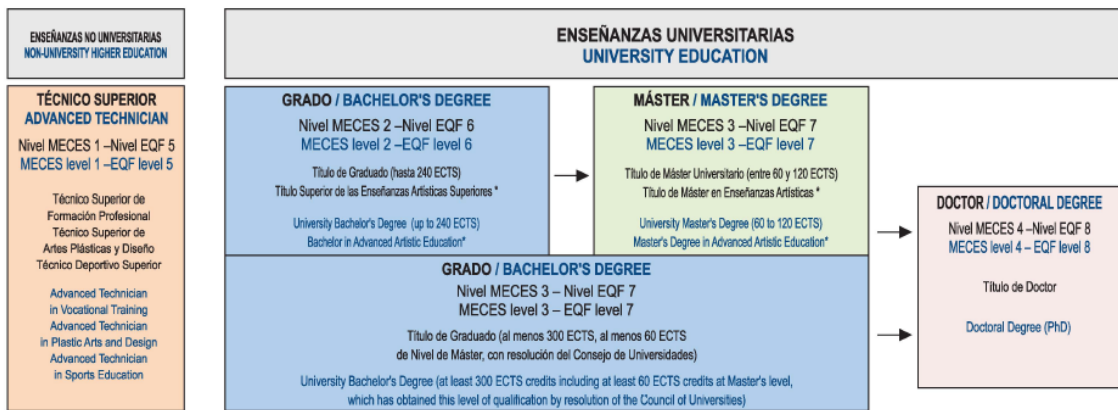
The M. A. in Initiation to Research in Art History focuses on training future researchers in this topic, helping them to carry out research initiation activities with autonomy, initiative and critical sense. That's why this M.A. offers advanced and specialized training in Art History and promotes the development of competencies linked to the methodological rigor that should characterize the research work on the main topics related to the area.

The aim competences are: Detailed and well-founded understanding of methodologies and theoretical/practical aspects of Art History, in a context of initiation to research; Knowledge of the main topics of the current research agenda in Art History, in order to interpret their contents and draw conclusions about them; Knowledge and selection of the appropriate media and supports to carry out an effective dissemination of research results in Art History; Application of the resources belonging to Art History's main research centers (archives, libraries, museums) to a process of initiation to research; Formulation of research initiation proposals, which integrate specialized knowledge in Art History in multidisciplinary contexts.
