#### INFORMATION ON THE LEVEL OF THE QUALIFICATION

#### Level of qualification

Level 3 (Master) in the Spanish Framework of Higher Education (MECES) is equivalent to level 7 of European Qualification Framework (EQF).

#### Official length of programme

The official length of programme is 60 ECTS and 1 year full time.

#### Access requirements

By virtue of the nature of the master's degree, priority will be given to students who are in possession of any of the following qualifications:

• Bachelor's degrees in Philology or Literary studies, Theory of Literature and Comparative Literature or other similar fields.

- Bachelor's degrees in History, History of Art, Geography, Archaeology or similar fields.
- Bachelor's degrees in Philosophy, Anthropology or other similar fields.
- Bachelor's degrees in Translation and Interpretation, Humanities or other similar fields.
- Bachelor's degrees in the area of Library Science and Documentation.

The master's degree will also be open to graduates in any other specialty, although with a different scale depending on the student's origin.

There are no leveling subjects as the master's degree is eminently methodological, so it cannot replace a basic humanistic training. It is understood that if someone from another branch of knowledge takes it, it will be because of their interest in its application to other disciplines.

The program of studies is composed of 31 compulsory ECTS, 20 elective ECTS and 9 Master's Dissertation ECTS.

#### **Grading scheme**

In the Spanish university system, modules/courses are graded on a scale of 0 to 10 points with the following qualitative equivalence:

0-4.9: "suspenso"; 5-6.9: "aprobado"; 7-8.9: "notable"; 9-10: "sobresaliente". A special mention, "Matrícula de Honor" may be granted to up to 5% of the students in a group provided they have got a "sobresaliente". To pass a module/course it is necessary to get at least 5 points.

In cases of recognition of ECTS, professional experience, cultural or sports activities, or student representation no grading will be recorded but, where appropriate, the word "Apto".

#### INFORMATION ON THE FUNCTION OF THE QUALIFICATION

#### Access to further study

This qualification gives access to Doctoral studies, provided that the student has completed a minimum of 300 ECTS in the overall teachings of Bachelor and Master.

Stated objectives associated with the qualification and professional status (if applicable)


The aim is to equip researchers and professionals with competences in digital humanities, through training in resources and tools useful for research, transfer and profession, enabling them to pursue doctoral studies, improve professional and transfer competences specialized in this field in the context of the search for sustainability.

It is an inter-faculty master's degree (Geography and History, Philology, Philosophy and ETSI of Computer Science) to (i) implement knowledge, resources and digital techniques useful for the profession and research of humanists; (ii) optimize and enrich the professional, research and transfer results to be achieved; (iii) offer a new vision that involves a change in research methods and activities for the analysis of the results, their impact and their visibility.
